The event was the opening of a four-day workshop on the EU and Human Rights, organized by AEGEE. The theme of the workshop was 'the EU and human rights'. Young people from all over Europe came together to prepare for the EU elections, and to discuss human rights in Europe, youth participation and EU institutions. The workshops culminated in a festival, Speak Europe. Prof. Oomen held an introductory lecture in which she shared ETHOS findings on justice in Europe, in particular the role of human rights in the early days of the institutionalization in Europe, and the place of human rights in Europe today.
